They say that cleanliness is close to godliness. So, parts of the house are clean, but my mind is still cluttered. Now it's time to really think about what to keep and what to get rid of.


I have bags and boxes ready to give away. I feel 10 pounds lighter. I recommend spring cleaning for anyone in need of clearing the cobwebs from your mind!


